# HIV Care in Neno District, Malawi <br> Neno Ministry of Health + Partners In Health 



## Background

- Neno is an agricultural district located in the southwest corner of Malawi
- An estimated 137,000 ${ }^{1}$ people live in Neno District in 2013
- Adult HIV Prevalence in Malawi: 10.6\% and in Southern Malawi: 14.5 ${ }^{2}{ }^{2}$

- Rural district where $23 \%$ of population walk 5+ miles to reach one of our 13 health facilities



## Highlights N ?

8\% of adults in Neno were tested for HIV between Jan-Jun 2012, compared to national avg of 3-5\%
6,117 patients living with HIV currently registered in care ${ }^{3}$
$96 \%$ of our 669 pre-ART patients have attended a visit in past 6 months ${ }^{3}$
5,448 patients on ARV treatment with $98 \%$ of our patients visited a health facility in past 3 months ${ }^{3}$
$94 \%$ ART cohort was alive and on ART at 12 months, compared to $79 \%$ nationally ${ }^{4}$

## HIV Care Model

- HIV Testing \& Counseling: offered at all facilities \& dedicated HTC counselors available weekdays
- HIV Care Clinic: available at all facilities providing ART, pre-ART, EID, and PMTCT care using 2011 Malawi Integrated HIV Care Guidelines, plus our mobile HIV care team regularly attends with portable CD4 machine
- Village Health Workers: 820 Village Health Workers provide patient support, ensure treatment plan adherence, and accompany patients to their clinic appointments
- Program on Social and Economic Rights: conducts home visits and connects vulnerable patients to direct cash assistance, housing renovations, vocational training and transportation to appointments
- Food Package: patients initiated on ART receive a food package for 4 months, \& pregnant women receive a food package for 2 months, 6 months after birth, and baby receives food until first birthday
- Maintain Electronic Medical Record System: contains up-to-date data from patient pre-ART and ART mastercards for routine monitoring and evaluation
- Treat Kaposi Sarcoma: 120 patients have received chemotherapy for KS at Neno District Hospital since 2008
